COVID-19 AND HOW IT EFFECT THE ISLAND THEATER

August 6, 2020

As we have said in our previous press releases - we are closely monitoring the current health situation in the state of Florida. The Island Theater's top priority is the health and safety of our students, patrons, actors and volunteers. We are currently open for business with the following precautions:

Audience patrons are strongly encouraged to wear masks to the performances.

Although not required by law in Clay County, we are providing masks at the box office as well as posting signs suggesting it.

Volunteers in the lobby and public areas are required to wear masks.

We have installed hand sanitizing stations throughout the theater.

Audiences are capped below 50% capacity and social distanced by party during performances.

Students, Casts and Crews are screened for health indicators and temperatures are checked prior to participation in rehearsals and performances.

Masks are required during non movement focused rehearsals

Audience members are not permitted to enter the facility when ill and tickets are quickly refunded for non-attendance due to illness.

The theater is sanitized before and after performances, rehearsals and activities.

Actors, Volunteers and Crew are instructed to withdraw from any production or activity should they decide to test for COVID until they receive their negative result. We have set a policy of casting understudies to ensure productions are minimally effected while we stand fast on healthy participats only.
