*50/50 change

- Jill lead conversation about a new 50/50 process. Instead of patrons being able to buy them with raffle tickets there will be a separate ticket for 50/50 and you will buy that ticket for \$5 each
- We're green lighting this for Anastasia to see how it will work out.
